

Assistance During the Ceremony

On the day of the ceremony, you should be focused on family, friends and your loved one, not hosting an event. Our licensed team displays memorial items and photos to have present at the ceremony. If a video tribute is planned, we meet with the video technician prior to test the video and audio equipment. All enhancements for the ceremony will be confirmed and all participants compensation will be distributed.

We receive and photograph the flowers as they arrive so that you have a record of who sent each piece. Our team ensures that seating is reserved for family, special guests and all displays are properly presented.

We manage parking and reserve parking areas for the family and provide staff to assist when space is limited. All-Natural Green Burial offered exclusively through Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam.

Natural Green Burial offers a unique all-natural method to traditional burial. A biodegradable casket or shroud will be used to place the deceased in a hand-dug grave space. A concrete outer enclosure is not used in this unique method of disposition. After the interment, a river rock is placed to mark the space.

No chemical treatment is used in this process. Private visitations may still be performed without embalming.



COMMITMENT TO CREMATION CARE

Your Loved One Never Leaves Our Care

Many funeral homes outsource the most important part of cremation, the cremation process itself. We strongly believe in <u>never</u> doing so. We transport and care for the deceased and operate our own crematory to ensure the level of care meets our community's standards.

Positive Identification

We have a unique process for identifying those entrusted to our care. First, we immediately place a personal identification bracelet on the deceased that is recorded into our proprietary system. Then, fingerprints may be secured, and all personal property inventoried. Next, a unique identification number is given to the deceased. This number is used throughout the cremation process, and a stainless-steel tag with this number accompanies the decedent during the cremation. Finally, we have multiple assurance points to verify all wishes and directives are followed before, during and after the cremation.

Private Farewell

The opportunity is always offered to have a final viewing in a comfortable atmosphere at our convenient locations. Everyone in our care is bathed with dignity and optional dressing in clothing of choice is available.

Certified Crematory Operator

Our crematory operators have been through an extensive training and certification process. A majority of our operators are also licensed funeral directors.

Returning Cremated Remains

When cremation is complete, all cremated remains are secured in an inner liner and clearly labeled. Once sealed, they are placed in the urn selected.



PROFESSIONAL SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF

Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff and Overhead

Our fee for the services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, twenty-four hours availability, consultation with family; sheltering of remains; arrangement of funeral; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation and listing of obituary notices; staffing assistance prior to, and following the funeral, including coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g. cemetery, crematory and others. In addition, this fee includes a proportionate share of our basic overhead costs.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

Embalming

Embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. This charge includes disposal of regulated medical waste and compliance with OSHA Bloodbourne Pathogen, Formaldehyde, Hazardous Material Communication and Health and Safety Standards/Regulations. Embalming may be required in certain special cases, including transportation of remains via Commercial Carrier.
