John was retired at the time of his passing after working about 30 years at the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission. He is preceded in death by his beloved mother, Helen Louise Price, and his father, Tobin Everett Price, Sr. He is survived by his wife, Jennifer Anne Birdsall, and his two daughters, Emily Gayle Price and Patricia Claire Price.
