Joyce Harvie Stetson of Rock Hall, MD went to be with the Lord Saturday, April 11, 2020 at age 86.

Joyce Elaine Harvie was born September 13, 1933 in North Anson, Maine, the daughter of the late, Fred E. Harvie and Florence Cushing Harvie. She was a 1952 graduate of Anson Academy and served as her class salutatorian. Joyce left the state of Maine and started her career as a teacher with the Devereux School in Malvern, PA.
