Margaret Schuchardt Andahazy of Grasonville, MD died at home on Friday September 27, 2019. She was 77.

Born on February 19, 1942 in Trenton, NJ she was the daughter of the late Albert and Ethel Schuchardt. Peggy grew up in Mercerville, NJ and was a graduate of the Mercerville School and Cathedral High School in Trenton, NJ.
