



Aaron Campbell McKee-Wright

December 22, 1977 - March 29, 2016

Aaron Campbell McKee-Wright, 38, of Easton MD, died on March 29, 2016, at his home in Easton, of heart disease. 'Aron ' was born in St Petersburg, FL, on December 22, 1977, the son of Campbell Ross Wright and Aprille McKee-Wright.

He was raised on a farm on The Corsica River in Queen Anne's County, MD, graduating from The Country School in Easton, The Cambridge School in MA, the Institute for Audio Research, and from The University of Colorado with a degree in writing and film making.

He lived in New York City, Los Angeles, and Denver, where he recorded his music, wrote his stories and created many works of art with his welding and building skills, before starting his own company, "reHabanero Hot Sauce," creating gourmet hot sauce at The Easton Fire Dept.

In his brief life, he also graduated from the Outward Bound mountaineering school, attended the Lee Strasbourg Institute. Always the culinary autodidact and "foodie," Aron developed his skills as an expert in Indian Cooking, grinding and preparing his own spice blends, and being welcomed into the kitchens of the finest restaurants from coast to coast to hone his craft.

His sense of humor, and big, warm smile, and hugs will be missed by so many

of us.

He is survived by his parents, his sister Piper Murray Mckee-Wright, of Easton; his maternal grandmother, Margaret Taylor of Keyser, WV and Easton; and numerous uncles, aunts, cousins and friends.

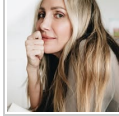
