Adelaide Anna Thompson died Monday, November 04, 2002 at Corsica Hills Nursing Home, Centreville, MD. She was 98.

Born on June 4, 1904 in Chester, MD, she was the daughter of the late Joseph and Adelaide Timms Coleman. She graduated from Stevensville High School in 1921 and in 1923 she married E. Earle Thompson of Chester. Mrs. Thompson taught school in Bryantown, Grasonville. She raised her family and in 1949 she returned to work as a concessionaire on the Matapeake Ferry System. After the Bay Bridge opened she went to work for the State of Maryland in the income tax division as a clerical worker. She retired in 1976.

She was a member of Kent island United Methodist Church and A.A.R.P.

Mrs. Thompson is survived by two sons, K. Wesley Thompson of Chester and Robert N. Thompson of Queenstown; a sister, Delma Buschman of Chester; 15 grandchildren and many great grandchildren. She was predeceased by her husband E. Earl Thompson; a daughter Pearl M. Tyler; brothers, Wesley Coleman, Ellison Coleman, Apsley Coleman, Purnell Coleman and Paul Coleman; and sisters, Myrtle Coleman, Ella Lewis, Edna Harris, and Lydia Coleman.
