



Adrian C.J. Deroy

November 15, 1932 - October 2, 2023

Adrian C.J. Deroy of Easton, passed away peacefully at home on October 2, 2023. He was 90 years old.

Born November 15, 1932, in Brampton, Ontario, Canada, to Cornelius Johannes de Rooy and Adriana Clara Maria van der Byl. He graduated from Easton High School in 1948. He was drafted into the U.S. Army in 1953, serving from 1953-1955 during the Korean War. After being discharged, he worked for C&P Telephone Co., holding various positions until retiring in 1985.

He married Janet M. Roe on February 16, 1955 and was a member of the SS. Peter and Paul Church, Regina Coeli Council Knights of Columbus, and Father Mosley Assembly Knights of Columbus. He enjoyed traveling, having visited all 50 states, and spending time with his family.

He is survived by his wife of 68 years; three daughters: Debra D. Blades (Harry), Donna D. Parks, and Julia L. Swann (Norman); six grandsons: Harry IV (Melissa), Douglas (Bridget), John (Jordan) Blades, Kevin Parks (Shelby), and Philip and Matthew Swann; ten great grandchildren; and sisters Marie Jewel and Wilhelmina Wright. He is preceded in death by his brothers Gerardus F. deRooy and William H.R. deRooy, and sister, Hendricka de Rooy Schmidt.
