Albert D. "Ducky" Toulson of Rock Hall, Maryland died on February 25, 2009 at Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown, Maryland. He was 72.

He was born in Fairlee, Maryland the son of the late James Andrew Toulson and the late Evelyn Kathryn Chaires Cornelius.

Mr. Toulson was educated in Rock Hall and Joined the Army National Guard Reserves where he served for 10 years. He worked with Milty Glenn who trained to become a brick mason. Mr. Ducky later worked with Allen Tyler and Sons for 20 years before starting his own business Ducky's Masonry, which he owned and operated until 2008.

Mr. Toulson married Nancy Stevens in 1965. He was a member of the Easton Moose Lodge and enjoyed crabbing, working on his antique truck, and during his retirement he spent time at the Rock Hall Lumber Company.

He is predeceased by his brother, James A. Toulson, Jr.

In addition to his wife he is survived by a son: Donald S. 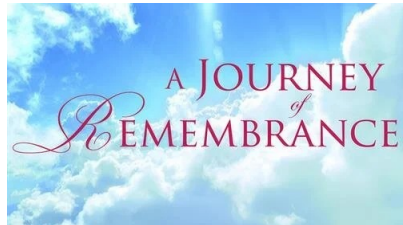

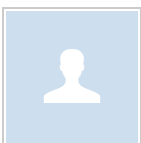
