



A. Dwight Hooper

May 23, 1941 - June 7, 2011

Arthur Dwight Hooper of Centreville, MD died at his home, surrounded by his family, on Tuesday, June 7, 2011 after a courageous battle with bladder cancer. He was 70.

Born in Baltimore, MD on May 23, 1941, he was the son of the late Arthur and Alma Harrison Hooper. He graduated from Mergenthaler High School, Class of 1958. He served in the U.S. Coast Guard and was honorably discharged. In 1961 Dwight married the former Marilyn Eaton; they would have been married 50 years on August 12. He and his family moved to Centreville in 1976.

Dwight began his career with the C & P Telephone Company in the mail room and worked his way up, retiring from Verizon in 1992. Following his retirement, he worked for Corsica Telecom as a systems tech until his illness. He also served as Vice President of C.W. A. Retirees.

He was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, friend, and fix-it guy. Known for his garden, he loved to cut grass and work outdoors. Dwight was an avid classic car enthusiast and a longtime friend of Bill W's.

In addition to his wife, Dwight is survived by two daughters, Amy Hooper Rhein and her husband, Mike, of Parkton, MD and Wendy Hooper Martin and her husband, Kevin, of Centreville, MD, and a sister, Anne Stocksdales and her

husband, Mel, of Catonsville, MD, three grandsons, Jacob, Nick and Ben, and two step-grandsons, KJ and Ryan.

A Memorial Service will be held on Saturday, June 18, 2011 at 11:00 AM at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A., Centreville. Friends and family may also visit at the funeral home on Friday, June 17, 2011 from 6 – 8 PM.
