Aileen Judd Vreeland, of Oxford, died at the Maryland General Hospital, Baltimore, on Friday, October 27, 2000.

She was 72. Born in New York City, August 24, 1928, she was the daughter of the late Roger Morris and Ethel Chapman Judd. As a teenager, she moved to Oxford with her parents. She graduated from Easton High School and then attended Mary Baldwin College. In June of 1949, she married G. Harry Vreeland and they made their home in Oxford. In 1960, they purchased the local Buick agency, the Mid-City Garage, which was re-named Vreeland Buick. She served as Vice-President of the company. Following the death of her husband in 1970, she remained associated with the business which was known as Robert A. Smith, Inc. trading as Vreeland Buick until the mid-1970"s.

A very active member of the Tred Avon Yacht Club where she served on Star-Class Race Committees, she served two terms as an Oxford Town Commissioner, was a full-time volunteer at the Chesapeake Rehabilitation Center, was Past President and Past Memorial Gifts Chairman of the Talbot County Unit of the American Cancer Society, was a longtime volunteer at the Waterfowl Festival and was instrumental in the founding of the Oxford Causeway Park. An avid sailor, she loved gardening and bird-watching

Mrs. Vreeland is survived by two daughters, Nancy A. Colket of Oxford and Virginia Vreeland of New Bedford, MA; two sons, Russell J. Vreeland and H. Judd Vreeland, both of Oxford and two grandchildren, Eric B. Andrew of Savannah, GA and Heather E. Anderson of Oxford.

Memorial services will be held on Tuesday, October 31st, at 2 P.M. at the Church of The Holy Trinity, Oxford. Private burial will be at the Oxford Cemetery, Oxford, MD
