A. Keith Tennier of Centreville, MD died at his home on Monday, April 19, 2010. He was 73.

Born May 14, 1936 in Oakland Bay area, CA, he was the son of the late Arthur and Shirley Hoffman Tennier. He graduated from Alameda High School, Class of 1954. He then enlisted in the U.S. Coast Guard and served for a total of 27 years, retiring as Chief Warrant Officer 4. In July 2004 they moved to Symphony Village in Centreville, MD.

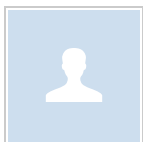
