Alan Edward Kleppinger, 82, of Easton, MD, died on Monday, August 29, 2016, at Bayleigh Chase Assisted Living in Easton. He was born on February 19, 1934, in Macungie, PA, son of the late Edward Halterman Kleppinger and Mable Ada Blain Kleppinger.

A resident of Easton since 1956, he worked at Sea Watch International, formerly Old Salt Seafood for 34 years in various positions, retiring as the Company Traffic/Production Manager. On August 18, 1956, he married the former Jean Marie Wyatt. They were happily married for 53 years until her death in 2009.

A past member of the Easton Volunteer Fire Department and the Easton Players, he was a member of the Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum and the Easton Elks Lodge # 1622. He was a Waterfowl Festival volunteer for many years and also volunteered with the Talbot County Chapter of the American Red Cross.

Mr. Kleppinger is survived by his three sons; Thomas C. Kleppinger, J. Kevin Kleppinger and his wife Kathie, all of Easton; Donald E. Kleppinger of Annapolis; eight grandchildren; and five great-grandchildren.

A funeral service will be held on Friday, September 2, 2016, at 11:00 AM at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., 200 S. Harrison St. in

Easton. A visitation will be held one hour prior to the service at the funeral home. Interment will follow in Woodlawn Memorial Park on Route 50 near Easton.
