Alan Dudley Higgins, Sr. of Easton died at the Memorial Hospital, Easton on Thursday, January 27, 2005. He was 81.

Born on April 26, 1923 in St. Michaels he was the son of the late William B. and Elizabeth Hunter Higgins. After graduating from St. Michaels High School, he was inducted into the United States Army where he served in the Pacific Theatre of Operations during World War II. Following his release from active duty in 1946, he returned to Talbot County where he began a career as a truck driver delivering propane products. Mr. Higgins, first wife of 52 years, Corinne Margaret Higgins died on October 24, 1994. In 2003, he married Manie M. Bechtel and they made their home in Easton.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Higgins is survived by a son, Alan D. Higgins, Jr. of Queen Anne, a daughter, Nancy Corinne Hicks of Federalsburg, four step children, Amy Bechtel and Nicholas Bechtel, both of Trappe, Angela Bechtel of Easton, Caroline Stewart and her husband Timothy of Springfield, VA, two sisters, Betty George of Easton and Helen Theis of Upland, PA, three grandchildren, Michelle, Amanda and Jon Philip, and five step grandchildren, Quartez, Joshua, Avery, Cameron, Noah, and several nieces and nephews.
