



Albert Joseph Hart III

January 25, 1935 - September 29, 2012

Albert Hart, III, of Chestertown, MD, died on Saturday September 29, 2012, at the University of Maryland Medical Center in Baltimore, MD. He was 77.

He was born on January 25, 1935, the son of the late Albert Joseph, Jr., and Harriet D. (Toal) Hart.

Mr. Hart was a graduate of Springfield High School and began with the Pennsylvania Railroad on October 24, 1952. During his tenure there, the railroad changed names to the Penn Central-Conrail and later to Amtrack. Mr. Hart retired as Forman Electrical Traction on May 30, 1997. He was married to the late Carolyn Mitchell who predeceased him on June 1, 1996. He later married Wilma Kyle on March 15, 1999, and they resided in Chestertown.

He was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church and Acting President of Kent Rutritan Club. He was also an active member of Chester Lodge #115 A.F.& A.M., and Past Patron of the Order of the Eastern Star Chapter #86 in Chestertown, MD. Mr. Hart enjoyed woodworking and fishing.

In addition to his wife, Wilma, he is survived by a son, Robert M. Hart of Chestertown; three daughters, Carolann Korte of Wisconsin, Elizabeth Pierce of Chestertown, MD, and Kathlyen Dougherty of AL; nine grandchildren; seven great-grandchildren; two brothers, Charles T. Hart and Brian L. Hart,

both of Wilmington, DE; stepsons, Jeff Kyle of FL and Michael Kyle of TN; along with six step-grandchildren. One son, the late Albert Hart, IV, died in 1983.

Services will be held on Thursday, October 4, 2012, at 11 a.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein, and Newnam Funeral Home, 130 Speer Road in Chestertown where relatives and friends may call on Wednesday, October 3, 2012, from 6 – 8 p.m. Interment will be in St. John's Catholic Church Cemetery in Rock Hall, MD.
