



## Albert Lee Ireland

April 15, 1932 - March 8, 2016

Albert Lee Ireland "Al" died peacefully on March 8, 2016, at his home. He was 83.

Born in Trappe, MD, on April 15, 1932, he was the son of the late William (Bill) Ireland and Margery Pennington Ireland Cole.

Al honorably served his country in the United States Army during the Korean War and Vietnam War. He retired from the U.S. Army in 1977 with over 25 years of service.

After retiring from the Army, he worked as an estate caretaker. He was a member of the American Legion and a former member of the Elks and Moose Lodge.

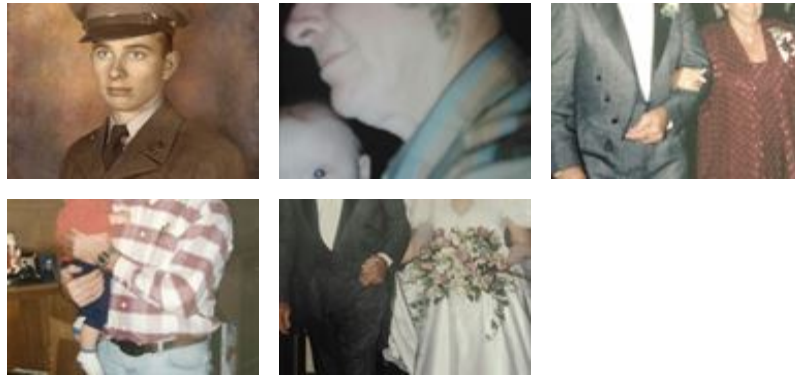

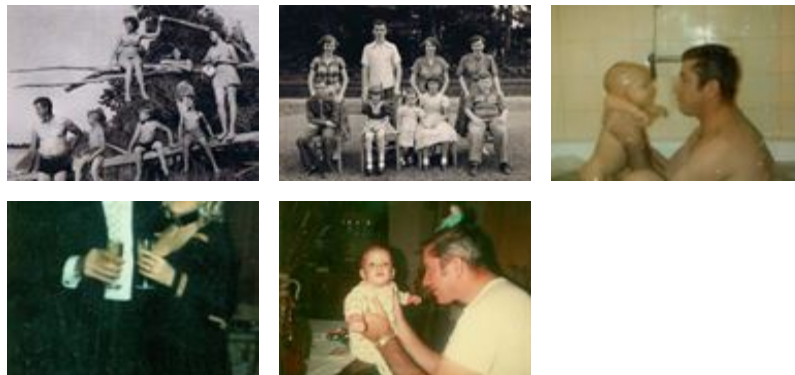
