



## Albert E. Mills

December 12, 1929 - November 11, 2017

Albert Eugene Mills, known to all as “Knobby,” passed away on November 11, 2017.

Born December 12, 1929, in Annapolis, MD, he was the youngest of eight children born to the late Bedford and Daisy Mills.

A Staff Sargent in the Maryland National Guard for 27 years, he worked for them as well. One of his fondest memories was being one of the drivers carrying the media, the day the Chesapeake Bay Bridge opened. He would tell all that he, not the governor, “opened the Bridge.” He worked for the United States Naval Academy, eventually retiring as Chief of Transportation.

Knobby was known late in life for his love of carving. A member of BPOE 622 and Easton Club East Carvers, he leaves lifelong friends and those he met since their move to Easton in 2003. He was a collector, card player, storyteller, and an Orioles fan to the end.

He was preceded in death by his siblings, Virginia Johnson, Bedford Mills, Lillian Smith, Betty Mae Donaldson, Mary Sears, Frank Mills and Thelma Childs.

He is survived by his wife of 64 years, Rosalee (June) Mills; daughters, Linda

Boyer (Captain James, ret. USN) of Spring, TX, and Judith Mills of Salisbury, MD; three grandchildren, Jamie (Jack) Shick, Laura (Michael) Poshard and Julie (Jason) Valdes, all of Spring, TX; and seven great-grandchildren, Hailey and Logan Valdes, Addison and Ryan Poshard, Benjamin and Harper Shick and Ripken Boyer. He is also survived by many nieces, nephews and extended families.
