



Albert John Rosenwald

December 4, 1927 - January 26, 2012

Albert “Jack” Rosenwald of Chestertown, MD, died on January 26, 2012, at Chester River Hospital Center. He was 84 years old.

Jack was born on December 4, 1927, in McKee’s Rocks, PA, and grew up in Emmitsburg, MD. He was the son of the late Albert H. and Margaret Rosenwald. A 1945 graduate of Emmitsburg High School, Jack enlisted in the United States Navy. He was honorably discharged in 1946 and enrolled at Mt. St. Mary’s College. He graduated in 1950 with a Bachelor's of Science Degree in Biology. Jack went to work for the United States Army at Ft. Detrick, MD. He occupied various governmental positions, retiring as the Technical Director of Armed Forces Medical Intelligence at Ft. Detrick, MD. He was awarded the National Intelligence Medal of Achievement in 1983. In retirement, Jack devoted himself to various avocations including gardening, boating, and cooking. He moved to Chestertown from Frederick County, MD, in 1997. He was a volunteer at the Upper Shore Mental Health Center in Chestertown, and a former member of the Rock Hall Yacht Club. He was a member of the Sacred Heart Parish.

He is survived by his wife of 58 years, Julia Arnold Rosenwald; a brother, Robert Rosenwald of Fairfield, PA; sons, John M. Rosenwald and wife, Frances, of Frederick, MD, James T. Rosenwald and wife, Anne, of Frederick, MD, Jeffrey A. Rosenwald and wife, Tammy, of Frederick, MD, and Joseph M.

Rosenwald and wife, Sophany of Rockville, MD; a daughter, Julie A. Armistead and husband, William, of Morgantown, WV; as well as eight grandchildren, Justin, Evan, Laura, Suzette, Celine, Sylvie, Blair, and Charles; and one great-grandchild, Brayden.
