



## Albert Vernon Stant

December 13, 1930 - January 23, 2021

Albert Vernon Stant passed away at Arcadia of Denton, MD, on January 23, 2021. He was 90 years old.

Born on December 13, 1930, in Willoughby, MD, Albert was the son of the late Albert H. and Laura M. Stant. He graduated from Centreville High School in 1947. He served in the United States Air Force from 1951-1955 and was a veteran of the Korean War. He was a past President and Chairman of the Board of the Queenstown Bank of Maryland.

Albert was an active and well-respected member of his community. His many services and activities include being a Life Member and Past Commander of the V.F.W. Post #7464, a Life Member of the Queenstown Volunteer Fire Company, and a member of the American Legion Post #296. He also served on the Restoration Committee for the Court House in Queenstown, MD, and the Queen Anne's County Civil Service Board.

His greatest joy was spending time with family and all his many friends, as well as helping his community.

He is survived by his wife, Jean M. Stant of Queenstown, MD; his daughter, Lynn S. Ludwig (John) of Chester, MD; and his son, Albert Andrew Stant (Joy) of Grasonville, MD. He is also survived by his grandchildren, Jeffrey Ludwig

(Katherine) of Marcellus, NY, Daniel Ludwig (Matthew) of Baltimore, MD, Kellsey Rogall (Johnny) of Easton, MD, Kasey Stant of Cockeysville, MD; and one great-grandson, Joshua Ludwig. He was predeceased by his sister, Gladys S. Crouch (William).

A private service will be held on Wednesday, January 27, 2021, at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home in Chester, MD.
