



Albert Curtis Thume

August 28, 1933 - June 18, 2024

Albert Curtis Thume passed away on June 18, 2024, at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Easton. He was 90 years old.

Curtis was born August 28, 1933, at "Boston" in the Trappe area, son of the late Solomon Albert and Virginia Daffin Thume.

Curtis graduated from Easton High School in 1952. He served in the Navy from 1952 until 1956 aboard the U.S.S. Massey. He was employed by C & P Telephone Company and retired from AT&T after 33 years of service. Upon retirement, he became the caretaker for "Connolly Point". Curtis married Joanne Louise Herd on December 22, 1956.

Curtis loved bluegrass gospel music and along with friends, sang in churches and nursing homes for many years. He loved fishing, hunting, crabbing, being outdoors and spending time with his grandsons. He also enjoyed his garden and fixing things.

Curtis was a member of the Trappe Emmanuel Wesleyan Chapel where he served as a trustee for many years.

He is survived by his wife Joanne, daughter Christine Hubbard (Steve) of Federalsburg, son Michael C. Thume (Catrechia) of Madison, 5 grandsons, 15 great-grandchildren and 1 great-great grandchild. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his sister, Alma T. Hall.
