Alberta Badoud Mills of Chester, MD died Saturday, April 21, 2007, at The Pines in Easton, MD. She was 88 years old.

Alberta was born on May 22, 1918 in Milford, Pennsylvania, to the late Mr. Vincent Badoud, Jr and May Ryder. In 1935 she graduated from Milford High School in Milford, PA. After graduation she went to work for Governor Pinchot as a private secretary. She held that position for seven years. She also worked at Governor Pinchot's estate in Milford and his home in Washington, DC, where she met her husband, Roland Mills. They later married on October 26, 1941 and lived in Landover Heights, MD. Roland worked for the federal government, while Alberta worked at the War Production Board and Office of Personnel Management. They lived in various MD locations, including Prince George's County and spent 20 years in Silver Spring, MD. In 1978, they moved to the Eastern Shore.

Alberta was a volunteer for the Girl Scouts of America. She loved politics and would often work the polling places. She was extremely active in the Woodside Methodist Church Women's Society and also at Kent Island United Methodist Church, where she was treasurer for over 10 years. Member of the Chester Homemakers, for many years She was an avid reader of books, until she became blind, and then listened to them on tape.

Alberta is survived by her loving daughter, Vina Mills of Chester, MD; 3 grandchildren, David and Erin Shawen of Frederick, MD, and Amber Thruman of Baltimore, MD; and sister, Iona Blood of Matamoras, PA. She was predeceased by her husband, Roland Mills; daughter, Laurel Thurman; sister, Anna May; and brother, Vincent Badoud.

A memorial service will be held on Thursday, April 26, 2007 at 11am at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A., 106 Shamrock Road, Chester, MD 21619. Internment will follow at the Woodlawn Memorial Park, Easton, MD.
