



Alberta G. Crane

May 20, 1914 - April 6, 2008

Alberta G. Crane of Easton, MD died on Sunday, April 6, 2008 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. She was 93.

Born May 20, 1914 in Brooklyn, NY, she was the daughter of the late J. Irving and Alberta Rose Jung Crane. After graduating from Westfield High School, Westfield, NJ in 1931, she attended Oberlin College where she earned a Bachelors Degree in 1936. She worked with the RHMacy training program at L. Bamberger & Co. and as a legal secretary to William T. Long. She was the Director of Christian Education at Linden Presbyterian Church and Townley Presbyterian Church and a buyer for the Jane Smith Gift Shop.

Her husband, William Portus Crane, whom she married in 1939, died in 1986.

She was a 50 year member of the Westfield Presbyterian Church where she taught Sunday school, was the Sunday School Superintendent and a member of the Church Women's Association. After moving to St. Michaels in 1974 she joined the Presbyterian Church of Easton; where she was an elder, a member of Presbyterian women and a member of the choir. She volunteered at Memorial Hospital for 30 years at the Commission Shop and the Gift Shop, and was a former member of the St. Michaels Women's Club, Izaak Walton League, Edge Creek Boat Club, the U.S. Power Squadron and the Sweet Adelines.

Mrs. Crane is survived by two daughters, Vivian C. Moore of Cumberland, MD and Shirley C. Reiner of Bel Air, MD; six grandchildren and five great-grandchildren. In addition to her husband and parents, she was predeceased by a son, Robert I. Crane and a daughter, Karen M. Crane.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday, April 12, 2008 at 11:00 AM at the Presbyterian Church of Easton, MD.

Burial will be at the Fairview Cemetery, Westfield, NJ.
