



## Albert Fulton Covington

Albert Fulton Covington of Easton, MD died on Friday, September 7, 2007 at Genesis Health Care – The Pines, Easton. He was 84.

Born February 19, 1923 in Snow Hill, MD, he was the son of the late Samuel F. and Carolina Dannenhauer Covington. He was inducted into the U. S. Army in 1943 and was honorably discharged in 1946. While serving in the Army in Europe, during World War II, he was wounded in action in Belgium during the Battle of the Bulge. After the war, he settled in Baltimore and worked for the National Can Company. In 1970 he returned to the Eastern Shore and settled in Queenstown and worked at the Beachcomber Restaurant until 1983. In 1993 he moved to Easton.

Mr. Covington is survived by his son, Roger F. Covington of Baltimore; one sister, Betty Wehr; four grandchildren, Samuel J. Covington, Daniel P. Covington, Rebekah E. Zubrowski and Caleb J. "CJ" Covington; and one great-granddaughter, Virginia E. Covington. He was predeceased by a sister, Lillian Bailey.

A visitation will be held on Monday, September 10, 2007 from 10:00 to 11:00 AM at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, MD. Services will follow at 12:00 Noon at the Maryland Eastern Shore Veterans Cemetery, Hurlock, MD.
