



## Albert Grant Shrader

Albert G. Shrader of near Church Hill, Md. died at the home of his daughter on Sunday May 13th. 2001 Of heart failure, he was 97.

Mr. Shrader was born in Maben West Virginia, the son of the late George and Zelia Shrader.

Early in Mr. Shraders life he worked as a Timber cutter. He then pursued a career in plumbing and worked with John Curlett until his retirement in 1975.

Mr. Shrader was a highly decorated veteran of WWII, receiving the Croix de Guierre ( the French equivalent to the Medal of Honor ) 1, Purple Heart and Two Bronze Battle Stars; Mr. Shrader served in Normandy, Northern France, Ardennes and Central Europe.

Mr. Shrader was a member of the Disabled American Veterans.

For most of his life Mr. Shrader enjoyed hunting and fishing. He also enjoyed gardening, reading and fixing and repairing most anything around the house.

At age 97, Mr. Shrader enjoyed riding his four-wheeler throughout the farm, and did so the morning of his death.

Mr. Shrader is preceded in death by his wife Ruth Caroline Shrader in 1980, as well as 7- Brothers and sisters.

He is survived by 1- daughter Zelia A Radtka and her husband Carl where Mr.

Shrader made his home for the past 7 years. 1- Grandchild and 2- Great Grandchildren.
