Albert I. Alstrom of Tilghman Island, MD, formerly of Longmeadow, MA and Agoura Hills, CA died Thursday June 14, 2001 at the Memorial Hospital at Easton, MD. He was 85.

Born in Hartford, CT, March 25, 1916, he was the son of the late Albert F. and Marion Thomas Alstrom. After graduating from Technical High School in Springfield, MA, he received a B.S. degree in Chemical Engineering from Tufts University in Boston, where he was a member of Delta Upsilon Fraternity.

He was Executive Sales Engineer for Wico Electric Co., West Springfield, MA, where he invented the Fly Wheel Magneto and registered several patents. During World War II, he worked as a consultant for Wico at the Pentagon. In 1966, he moved to California, where he was a Vice President at the McCullough Oil Corporation.

A resident of Tilghman Island, MD since August 1996, he was a member and the acting President of the Easton, MD Amateur Radio Club. While living in Agoura Hills he was a member of the Agoura Hills Friends of the Library and the Agoura Hills Amateur Radio Club. His memberships in Longmeadow included the Longmeadow Men's Club, the Longmeadow Auxiliary Police, the

Longmeadow Congregational Church and the Springfield Ski Club.
Professionally, he was a member of the Society of Automotive Engineers.

Mr. Alstrom is survived by his wife of 64 years, the former Dorothy M. Johnson, whom he married June 10, 1937; two daughters, Rondy J. Alstrom of Tilghman Island, MD and Linda A. Hare and her husband, Gordon of Edmond, OK and Atlanta KS; and a sister, Ruth Buckley of Minneapolis, MN.

Memorial services will be held on Wednesday, June 20, 2001 at 2:00 PM at the St. John's Chapel, Tilghman Island, MD.

Burial, at a later date, will be at the Pine Hills Cemetery in Westfield, MA.
