Albert J. Fichter of Chester, MD passed away suddenly on August 2, 2007 at Anne Arundel Medical Center. He was 65.

Mr. Fichter was born on July 26, 1942 in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania to the late Lawrence Fichter and Mary Siebert. He worked as a Government Contractor with Paragon Dynamics at Fort George G. Meade until 2006. He served over 22 years in the United States Air Force and retired as a Master Sergeant.
