Albert Ollson Allen, Sr of Centreville died Wednesday December 10, 2008 at the Chestertown Nursing and Rehab Center, MD. He was 80.

Born on April 3, 1928 at the Centreville Wharf he was the son of the late William O. Allen and Emma A. Stowman Allen. Albert grew up in Centreville and began working as a carpenter until serving in the Army. From 1946 to 1949 he served in the Army as a Military Policeman in Salisbury, Austria. After he was honorably discharged he returned to Centreville. In 1950 he married Emma G. Schuyler and they would reside in Centreville. Mr. Allen continued to work as a carpenter and work on restoring many of the historical sites in Kent & Queen Anne's Counties. He retired in 1990. Albert loved his lawn care and gardening. He also enjoyed watching wrestling and building furniture. He was a member of the Wye Mills United Methodist Church, a member of the American Legion Jeff Davis Post #18 and Life Member of the Disabled American Veterans.

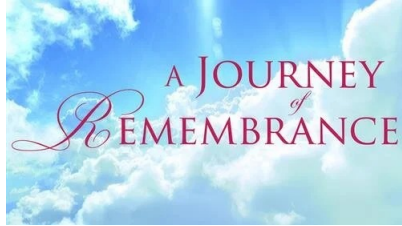

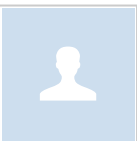

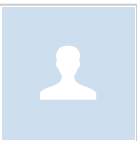
