Albert "Sonny" Q. Miles of Annapolis, MD passed away peacefully on Wednesday, February 11, 2009 at Anne Arundel Medical Center. He was 65 years old.

Born on March 17, 1943 in Fulton, Missouri, he was the son of the late Herbert Lawson Miles and Mary Florence Jennings. He was a graduate of Centralia High School in Missouri, Class of 1961. He received his Bachelor of Science degree in Electrical Engineering from the University of Maryland.
