



Alcinda M. Collier

August 12, 1919 - May 17, 2013

Alcinda Mae Collier of Lenoir City, TN, formerly of Grasonville, MD, died Friday, May 17, 2013, at Park West Medical Center, Knoxville, TN. She was 93.

Born on August 12, 1919, in Beverly, WV, Mrs. Collier was the daughter of the late Henry Enoch & Sarah Elmeda Weese Wamsley. She graduated from Beverly High School in 1936.

As a teenager of the Depression Era, she was involved with the National Youth Association, which was a program set up to educate and place young adults in a vocation. During WW II, she worked for Westinghouse in Baltimore, MD, as an assembly line worker. On February 17, 1946, she married Thomas C. Collier of Grasonville, MD. Together they resided in Grasonville for 47 years, where they raised three daughters. Mr. Collier died on August 13, 1988. In 1989, Mrs. Collier moved to Statesville, NC, to live with her youngest daughter and family.

She is survived by three daughters, Carolea A. Williams of Lenoir City, TN, Alcinda J. McNeal of Harmony, MD, and Sara Elizabeth Moore of Statesville, NC; a sister, Beatrice Douglas of AZ, a brother Henry Wamsley of Parkersburg, WV; four grandchildren; and twin great-grandsons. Two brothers, a sister, and a granddaughter predeceased her.

A graveside service was held on Tuesday, May 21, 2013, at Woodlawn Memorial Park in Easton, MD. The family requests that memorial contributions be made to the American Cancer Society, P.O. Box 163, Salisbury, MD, 21803, in lieu of flowers.
