Alday M. Clements of Chestertown, MD died on Wednesday, August 21, 2002 at Chestertown Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Chestertown. He was 89.

Born in Chestertown, MD, he was the son of the late Merrick and Elizabeth Burchinal Clements.

Mr. Clements was married for 65 years to Katherine Anthony Clements who predeceased him in January of 2001.

In 1950, he relocated his family to Puerto Rico where he served as a civilian on Ramey Air Force Base. He was superintendent of Repairs and Utilities with the Civil Engineering Squadron.

Mr. Clements returned to Chestertown, MD with his family in 1967 and continued his career at Dover Air Force Base in Dover, DE. He retired from Government Service in 1980.

An avid Golfer, Mr. Clements was a member of Chester River Yacht and Country Club for over forty years and served as its President in 1970, 1980, and 1981. He was active in Kent Conservation, the American Heart Association, Kent Museum, and attended First United Methodist Church.

Mr. Clements is survived by a daughter, Kittemeria Laroux of Chestertown,

MD; two sons, Anthony M. Clements of Reisterstown, MD and Christopher B. Clements of Buena Vista, CO; 7 grandchildren and 6 great grandchildren.

A memorial service and interment will be held at Chester Cemetery in Chestertown, MD at a later date to be announced.
