Aleksandra Humeniuk of Chestertown, MD, died on Friday, February 3, 2006. She was 95.

Born in Welyke Styce, Poland on October 12, 1910, she was the daughter of the late, Kypiran and Esabella Chorowycz Lypnycha.

In 1939, she married Petro Humeniuk and they lived in Wye Mills, MD. Mrs. Humeniuk was, for the majority of her life, a homemaker she had worked briefly at Wye Plantation (now the Aspen Institute) and with Caroline Poultry Farm. She emigrated with her family from Ukraine to the United States in 1949.

In 1998, her husband predeceased her, and in September of that same year, she came to Chestertown to live with her daughter.

She was a past member of St. Peter's Catholic Church, enjoyed crocheting and visiting with close friends and family.

Mrs. Humeniuk is survived by a son, Ihor "Pete" Humeniuk and his wife, Barbara of Easton, MD; a daughter, Vera Hadaway of Chestertown, MD; three grandsons, Mike Hadaway of Aberdeen, MD, Graham Hadaway of Chestertown, MD, and Bill and Amanda Hadaway of Surprise, AZ; five step-

grandchildren, Debbie and Bill Wood, Pam and Billy Kline, Raymond J. Gellert, Sr., Larry E. Gellert Sr., Tamra and Ozell Major; eight great-grandchildren and ten great-great-grandchildren.
