



## Alexander Riedy

A. Noble Riedy of Elkton, Maryland died on June 14, 2002 at Millcroft Nursing Center. He was 82.

Born in West Virginia he was the son of the late Dr. James and Maude Riedy, he was the husband of the late Helen Brice Riedy who predeceased him in 1997.

After moving to Maryland and later graduating from High School, Mr. Riedy attended Washington College in Chestertown, MD, and graduated with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Chemistry. He then took a job at DuPont as a chemist. Mr. Riedy served in the U.S. Navy during WWII in the European Theatre and was honorably discharged and then he returned to Wilmington and later moved to Newark while continuing with DuPont as a chemist. He later took a position as a Patent Agent in the Legal Department with DuPont where he worked until his retirement in 1992, after over 30 years.

Mr. Riedy was very involved in the Newark area with the Boy Scouts, a 32nd Degree Mason and a Republican Committeeman. Mr. Riedy was active with St. Thomas Episcopal Church and their Hope Dining Room Project. In later years he resided at White Chapel Village until shortly before his illness.

He is survived by a son, James Riedy of Elkton, MD; a daughter, Susan Riedy

Donahue of North East, MD; a sister, Dotty Williams of Chestertown, MD.

Memorial services will be held on Saturday, July 6, 2002 at 1:00 PM, at St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Chestertown, MD and on Saturday June 29, 2002 at 1:00 PM at St. Thomas Episcopal Church in Newark, DE.
