



Alfred Robert Allegra

January 27, 1936 - July 4, 2012

"Alfred "Fred" Robert Allegra of Centreville, MD passed away at the University of Maryland Hospital, Baltimore, MD on Wednesday, July 4, 2012. He was 76.

Born January 27, 1936 in Washington, DC, he was the son of the late, Alfred and Caroline Kessler Allegra. He graduated from Calvin Coolidge High School, Class of 1954. He then attended Montgomery Community College. He met his wife when he was 14 years old and on February 1, 1957 he married Sandra Fay Kelsey of Tacoma Park, MD. He was in the Naval Reserves, worked for the Montgomery County Police for eight years, and as an entrepreneur he worked several jobs until he created "Economy Distribution and Warehousing" which he ran for over 25 years. Mr. Allegra retired to Edgewater and later to Symphony Village in Centreville, MD.

He was a member of the Montgomery County Police Association and LaBona Vita Italian Club.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Allegra is survived by a son, Richard Lee and his wife, Margaret Ann Allegra of Millersville, MD; daughter, Tina Marie Worley and her husband Daniel Paul Worley of Spotsylvania, VA; and daughter Brenda Allegra Reilly of Chester, MD; five grandchildren, Dexter Daniel Worley, Brittanie Nicole Worley, Tiffanie Nichol Reilly, Alexander Joseph Allegra, and Crystal Marie Allegra, and one great grandchild, Conner Jennings

Worley. He was pre-deceased by a sister, Josephine.
