



Alfred "Babe" Carchedi

October 26, 1928 - November 1, 2015

Alfred "Babe" Carchedi of Silver Spring, MD passed away on November 1, 2015. He was 87.

Born on October 26, 1928 in Utica, NY, the son of the late Frank and Rosina DiRenzo Carchedi. He grew up in the Washington, DC area and lived in Silver Spring for the last 50 years. He was Senior Vice President of Consumer Credit for Riggs National Bank until his retirement, after 41 years, in July, 1987.

He is survived by his three daughters Angela Carchedi Wilson of Stafford, VA, Christina Rose Carchedi of Chester, MD and Carla Rene' Carchedi of Oviedo, FL; two grandsons Vincent Antonio Carchedi of Baltimore, MD and Mitchell Alexander Wright of Oviedo, FL; two brothers Arthur Carchedi of Silver Spring, MD and Albert Carchedi of Springfield, VA. In addition to his parents he was predeceased by his brother Anthony Carchedi.

A Celebration of Life Service will be held on Saturday, November 14, 2015. 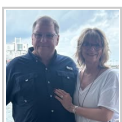

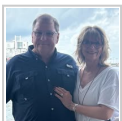
