



Alfred Bernard Feast

November 30, 1919 - January 19, 2013

Alfred Bernard Feast of Grasonville, MD died Saturday January 19, 2013 at his home surrounded by his loving family. He was 93.

Born in Baltimore, MD on November 30, 1919; he was the son of the late Alfred B. Feast and Edna Hoffman Feast Milke. He attended school in Baltimore, MD. On June 7, 1941 he married Ruth P. Moffett of Baltimore, MD where they resided. In April of 1943, Mr. Feast was drafted into the United States Navy and stationed on the USS Cabot, a CVL-28, during WWII. In 1944, he was medically discharged and returned home to his family. Once he returned home, he began working for Westinghouse, where he became a tool and die maker until retirement in 1978. In 1968, he and his wife moved to the Eastern Shore where they resided in Grasonville.

Mr. Feast was a member of the VFW Post #7464, American Legion Post #273, the Shriners of Baltimore and the Masonic Lodge of Centreville, MD. He enjoyed spending time with his loving family, wonderful friends, his dog Pickles, and the Chesapeake Bay where he took pleasure in fishing off his boat and pier. In October 2012 he just attended the 30th Anniversary of the USS Cabot in Myrtle Beach where he spent time with his fellow shipmates.

In addition to his loving wife of 71 years, Ruth, he is survived by two

daughters; Sharon Udovich and husband Leslie, Arlene Batton and husband Robert, one sister; Margaret Geisler MD, two grandchildren, Shawn Udovich and wife Ann Marie, Kelley Batton, two great grandchildren, Stephanie and Brady Udovich. One brother, Thomas Milke, predeceased him.

A funeral service will be held on Wednesday, January 23, 2013 at 11AM at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, Chester, MD, where family and friends may visit on Tuesday, January 22, 2013 from 2-4PM and 6-8PM.
