



Alfred R. Guerieri Sr.

January 8, 1924 - July 19, 2013

Alfred Robert Guerieri, Sr., 89, of Chester, MD passed away peacefully at his home surrounded by his loving family.

Born on January 8, 1924 in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late Peter N. Guerieri and Taide Bassetti Guerieri. Al graduated from Baltimore Polytechnic Institute in 1943, and served in the U.S. Army from 1943-1946. After his honorable discharge, he returned to Baltimore and graduated from the Maryland Institute in 1949. On May 7th of that same year, he married the former Gladys O'Brien. Al began his career as a Union Carpenter and at the time of his retirement in 1988, he was a general supervisor, superintendent and purchasing agent for several home builders. The Guerieris have lived on Kent Island since 1973.

Al was a 4th degree Knights of Columbus at Cardinal Gibbons, and a member of St. Christopher's Catholic Church, where he actively assisted with the re-design and recent expansion of the church. He was also a member of Blue Heron Senior Golf Club and the Maryland Home Builders Association. Al enjoyed woodworking, golf, kite building and flying, and spending time with his family and friends.

He is survived by his loving wife of 64 years, Gladys Guerieri; their children: Dennis Guerieri and his wife, Pamela, Alfred Guerieri and his wife, Susan,

Patricia Guerieri, Brian Guerieri and his wife, Heather, and Teresa Hunter and her husband, James; 10 grandchildren; and 6 great-grandchildren.
