July 11, 1919 - April 3, 2009

Alfred D. Jones of Chestertown, Maryland died on April 3, 2009 at Chester River Hospital Center. He was 89.

He was born in Philadelphia, PA on July 11, 1919 the son of the late Edmund and Mabel Collins Jones. He attended Overbrook High School in Pennsylvania and completed electronic courses. He married Marjorie Bedford on July 27, 1939, they resided in Pennsylvania. Mr. Jones served in the U.S. Navy from 1943-1945 during WWII as a Signalman Third Class in the Atlantic Theatre and was honorably discharged. He returned to Philadelphia where he owned and operated an appliance repair and sales shop. Mr. Jones then worked with NY Shipyard in Philadelphia, Upper Darby Sign Company, and with the Franklin Mint as head of the Electronics Department from which he retired after 25 years in 1985. He moved to Chestertown, Maryland in 1972 from Darby, PA. He was a member of the V.F.W. in Millington and the Masonic Lodge. He enjoyed square dancing with the Diamond Square Dance Club in Darby, PA. He was an avid reader, enjoyed western era films and legends, and most of all his family.

He was predeceased by his wife the late Marjorie Bedford Jones in 1999.

He is survived by two sons: Alfred Donald Jones and his wife Betty of Lincoln, California, John Robert Jones and his wife Terri of Glenolden, PA, a daughter: Susan Markow of Chestertown, MD, two sisters Mary D'Angelo of Darby, PA and Katherine McCollian of Collingdale, PA, along with thirteen grandchildren, thirty five great grandchildren, and four great great grandchildren. One son the

late Brian Jones along with three brothers predeceased him.

Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, April 7, 2009 at 1:00 PM at Fellows, Helfenbein, and Newnam Funeral Home 130 Speer Road Chestertown, MD where relatives and friends may call one hour prior to the service (12-1).
