Alfred Ronald Klabe of Chestertown, MD, died Saturday, May 9, 2015, at Chestertown Nursing and Rehabilitation. He was 85.

Alfred R. Klabe was born June 8, 1929, in New Castle, DE, the son of the late Alfred B. Klabe and Ella "Denn" Klabe. 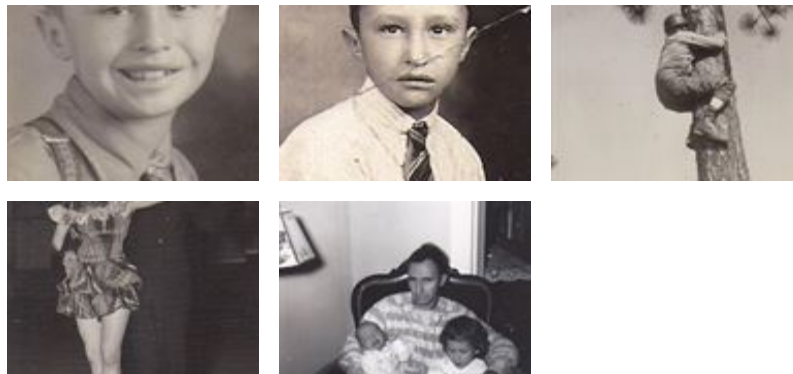
