Alfred Mason Haddaway of Easton, MD died on Tuesday, May 28, 2002 at Genesis Elder Care-The Pines, Easton. He was 86.

Born August 18, 1915 in Oxford, MD, he was the son of the late Calvin M. and Maude Cook Haddaway. After graduating from Oxford High School, he was employed by Koester's Bakery as a route salesman and then worked as a butcher before joining a local plumbing contractor as a heating and air-conditioning technician. Later he started his own heating and air-conditioning firm in which he was active until retiring in the late 1980's. During World War II, he served briefly in the United States Army.

A life-long resident of Talbot County and of Easton since 1937, he was a member of Grace Lutheran Church, Easton and a former member of Talbot Post #70 American Legion.

His wife, the former Mary Louise Satchell, whom he married in August of 1937, died in August of 1992.

Mr. Haddaway is survived by a daughter, Wanda Lee North of Easton; a son, Richard M. Haddaway of Poolesville; a sister, Laura H. Childress of Tucson, AZ; four grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, May 31, 2002 at 3:00 PM at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, MD where friends may call one hour prior to the service.

Burial will be at Spring Hill Cemetery, Easton, MD.
