Alice Clendaniel Hoxter of Queen Anne, MD, died peacefully at home on Wednesday, January 04, 2006. She was 86.

Born on March 15, 1919, in Stevensville, MD, she was the daughter of the late, LuLu V. Gardner and John O. Clendaniel. Mrs. Hoxter was a graduate of Stevensville High School.
