Alice Elizabeth Coleman Hoagland of Chestertown, MD, died on Wednesday, January 15, 2014, at Chestertown Nursing and Rehabilitation Center. She was 95.

Born on September 2, 1918, in Chestertown, MD, she was the daughter of the late Charles P. and Mertyl Uselton Coleman. Mrs. Hoagland was a graduate of Chestertown High School. She worked as a legal secretary and then worked as a Nurse's Aid for Chester River Hospital Center.

Mrs. Hoagland was a member of the American Legion Auxiliary in Fort Washington, PA, Trinity Lutheran Church, and also volunteered at Magnolia Hall. She enjoyed sewing, quilting and growing flowers and plants. Mrs. Hoagland was very strong willed and stubborn in most cases.

She is survived by two sons, John and Frank Ross; a daughter, Alva Ross; a sister, Ann; a brother, Billy; eight grandchildren; and numerous great-grandchildren and great-great-grandchildren.
