



Alice K. Wright

June 28, 1916 - May 4, 2010

Alice Kennedy Wright of Chestertown, MD, died on May 4, 2010, at Chester River Manor. She was 93.

Born in Chestertown, MD, on June 28, 1916, she was the daughter of the late, George Lloyd, Sr., and Blanche Groves Kennedy. Mrs. Wright graduated from Chestertown High School, Class of 1934 and Mason Frederick Beauty School in 1937. She owned and operated Alice's Beauty Salon in Chestertown until retiring in 1995. Mrs. Wright enjoyed politics, working on many political campaigns, serving on the Republican Central Committee, where she was a Kent County Representative and Delegate to the National Republican Convention, past President of Republican Women's Club of Kent County, past President of the Kent & Queen Anne's County Republican Women's Club, and a member of the League of Women Voters. She was also a member of the Kennedyville United Methodist Church, the Kennedyville Homemakers and the Red Hatters. Mrs. Wright enjoyed traveling, organizing and directing many bus trips, as well as serving as a Tour Director for Dorsey's Bus Service.

She was predeceased in 1969 by her husband of 30 years, John Wright, whom she married on February 18, 1939. She was also predeceased by a son, David Richard Wright; sister, Miriam Phillips; and brothers, Louis H. Kennedy and George L. Kennedy, Jr.

She is survived by three sons, John Lloyd Wright of Worton, MD, Wayne Morris Wright of Chestertown, MD, and Allan Kennedy Wright of Tucson, AZ. She is also survived by seven grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren; and two great-great grandchildren.

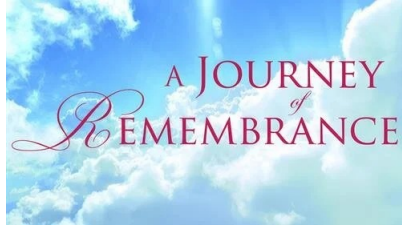

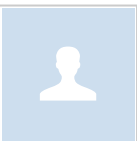
