



## Alice L. Kysar

May 28, 1934 - June 8, 2022

Alice Kysar (Logie) of Easton, MD, passed away on Thursday, June 8, at the age of 88.

Alice was born in Stuart, NE, to James and Lucie Logie. She attended schools in Bassett and St. Paul, NE, then graduated from the University of Nebraska at Lincoln in 1956. After leaving Nebraska in 1957, she lived in Chicago, IL; Nashville, TN; Nashua, NH; Leesburg, VA; and, lastly, Easton, MD.

Alice taught public school music and English classes in Nebraska and then worked as a dental assistant in both Nebraska and Tennessee. In Nashville, she went on to work at the Metropolitan Health Department and as a disability examiner for Social Security, retiring in 1999.

She was a member of St. Bartholomew's Episcopal Church in Nashville where she served on the diocesan work group for disability concerns for many years and was active in numerous community volunteer activities. In Nashua, NH, she was a member of St. Luke Anglican Church.

She is survived by her brother James (Robin) of Orlando, FL; her son, Jeffrey; daughter Amy (John) of Easton, MD; beloved grandchildren Paul (Mireille), Andrew, and Hillary (Nick); great-grandson Jack; great-granddaughters Wynn and Caroline; and several cherished nieces and nephews.
