Alice B. Nily, a resident of Easton, MD, passed away on December 14, 2017, at Hospice House in Easton, she was 97.

Alice was born on March 7, 1920, to Grace and Andrew Becker in Baltimore, MD. After graduating from Baltimore City College in 1938, Alice worked for C&P Telephone Co, the Baltimore Gas Co., and then in 1941, Waverly Press (Baltimore and Easton) where she stayed until 1963.

She married her husband, Vernon J. Nily, also of Baltimore in 1941, had one son, and the family moved to Easton, MD, with the new Waverly Press plant in 1949. In 1960, Alice began her real estate career part-time with Roy Lyons, Broker of Maryland Virginia Real Estate in Easton, and then in 1963, retiring from Waverly Press, started her own real estate brokerage in Easton, not retiring until the age of 88 in 2008. Her vocation was real estate but her avocation was bridge, and she did both with a passion. She worked her entire life and energized those around her to always try to do more.

In addition to her parents, Alice was preceded in death by her husband Si, and siblings Grace, Andrew, Edward and Paul. She is survived by her son Vernon Nily, Jr. (Gay), grandchild, Allison Pattillo and husband John, and great grandchildren Adair and Taylor.
