ALLAN EARL MISENER, 89 (1935-2024) sadly passed away at his home in Easton, MD on July 25, 2024. He was proud to be Grandpa to six grandchildren and ten great-grandchildren. He also leaves behind other family members and friends. Allan attended Poly Technical Institute and Johns Hopkins University studying engineering. He served in the United States Navy Reserves as a Communication Technician and honorably discharged in 1961.

The family enjoyed annual vacations to Ocean City, MD, day trips on Sundays to festivals, historical sites, exploring Baltimore and the surrounding counties as well as summers swimming at Rusty Rock Swim Club. Early retirement afforded Allan and Joyce the opportunity to retire to Melbourne, FL. They enjoyed extensive travel, cruises, and trips to visit family and friends.

Allan's last months were spent with family, making new friends, becoming active in his residential community, and exploring all that Easton had to offer. He will be forever loved and missed.
