Allan Frank Price of Chestertown, MD went home to be with the Lord on Saturday, January 24, 2026. He was 91 years old.

Allan was born in Baltimore, MD on May 4, 1934, the son of the late Allan Washington Price and Eva J. Price. Later, the family moved to Rock Hall, MD, where Allan graduated from Rock Hall High School with the class of 1953.

After graduating, he decided to join the United States Army, where he served for two years. Following his discharge from the Army, he was hired by the federal government and began his career of over 40 years with the Central Intelligence Agency.

Allan loved to travel, visiting places such as Germany, Turkey, and Vietnam over the years. His favorite time of year was Christmas, especially sharing the holidays with his family.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a brother, Donald L. Price, Sr., and a nephew, Donald L. Price, Jr.

He is survived by a niece, Michele Jordan (Doug); great-nieces: Katie Hardin, Kayla Price, Heidi Thompson, Ashley Ames, and Christine Price; a nephew, Thomas Hardin; as well as many great-great-nieces and nephews.
