



Allan Joseph Sidlow

August 10, 1942 - January 27, 2012

Allan Joseph Sidlow of Sudlersville, MD, formerly of Pennsylvania and Maryland, died Friday, January 27, 2012, at the Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown, MD. He was 69.

Allan J. Sidlow was born in Chester, PA, the son of the late Joseph Lewis Sidlow and Lillie “Churrick” Sidlow. Mr. Sidlow was a 1960 graduate of Penn Crest High School in PA. After high school, he went in to the police academy and then went to work for the Upper Providence Police Dept. for two years and then for the Nether Providence Police Department where he retired as a Sergeant in August of 1997 after 31 years of dedicated public service. While working at the police dept. he also served in the National Guard.

After retirement, he went to work for Longwood Garden and the Brandywine River Museum working security. He married Joyce A. Sidlow on December 22, 1983. Mr. Sidlow was a member of the Delaware County F.O.P. Lodge 27, the George Bartram-Paul Sand Masonic Lodge #298, the American Miniature Horse Assoc., the Virginia Horse Show Assoc., the American Mule and Donkey Society, and the Arabian Horse Assoc., and the P.H.S.A. He enjoyed boating, raising and breeding horses, working on the computer, watching t.v., and helping his wife with her antique shop. He was a loving husband and tremendous public servant and loved to party with his friends.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his stepdaughter, Mollie Makant, on April 1, 2011

He is survived by his wife, Joyce A. Sidlow of Sudlerville, MD; one sister, Doris E. Sidlow of Media, PA; two grandchildren, Jeremy Saulisbury of Sudlersville, MD, and Tiffany Lloyd of Seaford, DE; and two great-grandchildren, Tristen and Trace, both of Seaford, DE.

A visitation will be held Saturday, February 4, 2012, from 10 a.m. to 11 a.m at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, 370 Cypress St., Millington, MD. A Masonic service will be held at 11 a.m.

Burial will be held in New Garden Friend's Cemetery, 875 Newark Rd., Avondale, PA, following the service at 3 p.m.
