Allan Jeremiah Samuel Sipes died on Tuesday, May 12, 2009 at his home surrounded by his loving family. He was 79 years old.

Born on November 4, 1929 the son of Eugene Perry Sipes and Edna Mary Whitfield in Little Orleans, MD. He graduated from Flintstone High School in the Class of 1947. He served in the U.S. Air Force during the Korean War from 1948 to 1952. Mr. Sipes married Elizabeth Boffen of Elkridge, MD on June 19, 1955 and it is there they raised their family. Mr. Sipes worked for Armco Steel of Baltimore for twenty-six years.

Mr. Sipes was a member of the Queen Anne's County Red Cross and Kent Island American Legion Post #278. He also served as Boy Scout Leader of the National Pike District for twenty years. Mr. Sipes was a member of Christ Episcopal Church in Stevensville, MD.
