August 21, 1927 - June 4, 2010

Allen Rufus Malcolm of Chestertown, MD died on June 4, 2010 at Memorial Hospital in Easton.

Born in Westfield, NJ on August 21, 1927 he was the son of the late, Talbot and Margaret Richart Malcolm. Mr. Malcolm trained as a Navy pilot during World War II. He was a graduate of Wesleyan University and of Cornell Law School. He worked for the Irving Trust Company of New York, NY retiring in 1984. Mr. Malcolm continued to work as an officer of the John Ben Snow Foundation and was a Trustee of that foundation for over 40 years. Before moving to Maryland, he was active in the community of Westfield and was Past Master of the Masonic Lodge there. After moving to Maryland, he was a member of the St. Andrews Society of the Eastern Shore, the Presbyterian Church of Chestertown, the Chester River Yacht and Country Club. Mr. Malcolm was also an active supporter of the Sultana Projects.

In addition to his wife, Gerry H. Malcolm, he is survived by daughters, Marcia Malcolm of Westfield, NJ, Uma Malcolm of Mt. Shasta, CA, and Valerie Malcolm MacFie and her husband, Richard of Howell, NJ; a son, Robert Malcolm and Karen Webb of Worton, MD; a brother, Dr. Bruce Malcolm of South Carolina; a sister, Margaret Smith of Chestertown, MD; three grandsons, James MacFie of Freehold, NJ, Brian MacFie and his wife, Jennifer of Howell, NJ and Galen Malcolm of Portland, OR, also survived by

two great grandsons, Nicholas and Charles MacFie of Howell, NJ.

A memorial service will be on Saturday, June 19, 2010 at 11:00AM at the Presbyterian Church of Chestertown.

Interment will be held privately at Fairview Cemetery.
