Alma Marie Kelly of Lincoln University and Earleville, MD died Sunday, November 27, 2005, in Lankenau Hospital, Wynnewood, after a brief illness. She was 74.

Mrs. Kelly was born February 15, 1931 in New Jersey, she was the daughter of the late, Frank and Blenda Carlson Hicks.

She received her B.S. and Masters in Education from Seton Hall University.

Mrs. Kelly had taught for 42 years in New Jersey, teaching Elementary Education in the Newark Parochial Schools, South Plainfield School District, Springfield Reg. School District and Bridgewater-Raritan School District from which she retired after 31 years of service. She was listed as an "Outstanding Teacher of Elementary Education" in 1973 and also received a Certificate of Recognition from the Governor of New Jersey in 1990 on behalf of the Teachers Recognition program.

She enjoyed gardening, traveling and spending time with her family.

Mrs. Kelly was an active member of the New Jersey Education Association, New Jersey Classroom Teachers Association, Bridgewater-Raritan Teachers Association, Bradley Gardens PTA, Somerset County Teachers Association,

and 4-H, where she frequently served as Horse show secretary.

Mrs. Kelly is survived by her husband of 48 years, Emmett Richard Kelly of Earlville; a daughter, Brenda Higgins of Wilmington, DE; a sister, Katherine Hicks of New Holland and a granddaughter, Caitlin Higgins of Wilmington, DE.

Services will be 11 a.m. Friday in Old St. Paul's Episcopal Church, Chestertown.

Burial will be in St. Paul's Cemetery, Chestertown.
