Alta Mae “Peg” Weston of Easton, MD, formerly of Denton, died on Thursday, November 1, 2007 at Talbot Hospice House, Easton, MD. She was 90.

Born January 6, 1917 in Inkster, ND, she was the daughter of the late Alfred M. and Elsie Lavina Spengler Hanson. After graduating from high school, she attended Union Commercial College in Grand Forks, ND and was later Secretary to U. S. Congressman Usher L. Burdick of North Dakota for seven years. On November 9, 1940 she married David T. Weston at the Lutheran Church of Reformation, Washington, D.C. They made their home in Silver Spring, MD prior to moving to Denton in 1987. Since 2006 they have resided in Easton.

She was a member of First Wesleyan Church, Easton, MD.

In addition to her husband, Mrs. Weston is survived by two children, Dr. Thomas Weston and his wife Renee of San Diego, CA, and Jon D. Weston and his wife Karen of Rockville, MD; a sister, Muriel “Sis” H.
